TEF (Test d'Évaluation de Français) and TCF (Test de Connaissance du Français) are official French language proficiency exams recognised by the Government of Canada.

Both tests:

- Evaluate your French in Listening, Speaking, Reading & Writing
- Convert your scores into CLB (Canadian Language Benchmark) levels
- Are used for Express Entry, Provincial Nominee Programs (PNP), and other immigration pathways

Do I Need Both Exams?

You only take one, either TEF OR TCF.

Both are accepted equally for immigration purposes.

What score do I need?

Immigration Goal	Minimum Level Required
Francophone Mobility Work Permit Extension	CLB 5 → equivalent to B1 in Listening and Speaking
Canadian PR (Express Entry)	CLB 7+ → equivalent to B2+ in all four sections

(Higher the French level → higher the points → higher the chances of PR.)




For rescheduling or cancelling a class, a prior notice of 24 hours before the scheduled time is mandatory.

These levels represent stages of language proficiency as defined by the CEFR (Common European Framework of Reference for Languages):

- A1-A2: Beginner to Elementary
- B1-B2: Intermediate to Upper Intermediate

2) Why can't I skip levels?

→ Skipping levels can create gaps in foundational knowledge, making advanced topics difficult to grasp. Mastering each level ensures steady progress and builds confidence.

3) Why are there no group classes?

→ Group classes often lack:
